



### NATIONAL

#### **Canada becomes second nation to legalize marijuana**

Canadian Parliament has passed a “historic” bill legalizing the recreational use of marijuana nationwide, becoming the second country in the world to do so

#### **US quits UN human rights council**

US envoy to UN Nikki Hally, calling UNHRC a ‘cesspool of bias’ and blaming for its anti-Israel stance, announced to pull out of UNHRC.

#### **India’s exports hit six month high in May**

India’s exports grew 20.18 percent to \$28.86 billion in May, recording the highest number in six months. India’s trade deficit widened to a four-month high of \$14.62 billion in May as imports surged nearly 15%.

#### **11th Common Review Mission Report Released**

Shri Ashwini Kumar Choubey, Minister of State for Health and Family Welfare released the 11th Common Review Mission (CRM) report of the National Health Mission. Speaking at the function, Shri Choubey stated that India has registered a record 22% reduction in MMR since 2013, which is the highest percentage decline so far when compared to all the previous reductions in MMR as per the earlier rounds of SRS.

#### **Wholesale inflation hits 14-month high**

India’s inflation measured by the Wholesale Price Index (WPI) rose to a 14-month high of 4.43% in May as compared to 3.18% in April, government data revealed. Vegetable prices grew by 2.51% in May, while primary articles that account for over one-fifth of the entire WPI, grew by 3.16%.

#### **TCS becomes first Company to close over Rs. 7 Trillion Market Cap**

India’s IT major Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) became first listed company in India to close day’s trade with market capitalisation (m cap) of over Rs. 7 lakh crore (over \$103 billion).

### **Reliance Industries from India to rank under top-100: Forbes**

Reliance Industries at 83rd place, the only from India in the top-100. HDFC has been ranked as the 5th biggest public company globally in the ‘consumer financial services category’ compiled by Forbes in its 16th annual Forbes Global 2000 list. American Express tops the chart. Tata Motors at 385 , TCS at 404, L&T at 471st , SBI at 489th.

### **India at the bottom of EPI**

India has ranked 177 out of 180 countries in the Global Environment Performance Index (EPI) rankings, as per the State of India’s Environment (SoE) 2018 in Figures that has been released recently. Centre for Science and Environment (CSE) helps to publish it.

### **Three Indian cities among top 10 for GDP risk from terrorism**

Three Indian cities, including Delhi, Mumbai and Bengaluru are ranked among the top 10 cities globally for GDP risk from terrorism threats, a recent study found out. Delhi, Mumbai and Bangalore stood at fifth, sixth and seventh in this aspect, in the latest edition of Lloyd’s India’s City Risk Index (CRI).

### **IIT Bombay Displaces IIT Delhi As Best-Ranked Indian University**

Three Indian universities feature in the top 200 universities of the QS World University rankings 2019. These includes-Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Bombay, Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bangalore and IIT Delhi.

Government of India has constituted a group of eminent persons to study the Special Economic Zones (SEZ) Policy of India. The group will evaluate the SEZ policy, suggest measures to cater to the needs of exporters in the present economic scenario and make the SEZ policy WTO compatible, suggest course correction in SEZ policy, make

### **India among top 5 in e-waste generation**

India is among the top five e-waste generating countries in the world besides China, the US, Japan and Germany, according to a report. Among states, Maharashtra contributes the largest e-waste of 19.8% but recycles only about 47,810 tonne per annum (TPA), the report released by Assocham and NEC.

### **India's Forest cover stood at 21.34% in 2015**

India's forest cover stood at 21.34% in 2015, an increase of 1.29 percent from 2009, according to a government report on the environment. The Status of Environment Report, India 2015, was released by Environment Minister Harsh Vardhan.

### **IISc Bangalore back in world top university list**

Bengaluru's Indian Institute of Science (IISc) has made it to the list of top 100 in the World Reputation Rankings 2018. It ranked at 91, Indian Institute of Science is the only Indian University to have made it to the prestigious list. The list was topped by Harvard.

## STATES

### Punjab Government Launched Mobile App- 'i-Hariyali'

To increase the state's green cover, the Punjab government has launched 'i-Hariyali' app that lets users order free plant saplings. The 'i-Hariyali' app under 'Mission Tandarust' can be downloaded from the app store for free. The users can book a sapling of their choice, a maximum of 25 per person, from a nearby government nursery.

### Governor's Rule imposed in J&K

President Ram Nath Kovind has given his assent to imposition of Governor's rule in Jammu and Kashmir. This is the eighth time in the last four decades J&K was put under Governor's rule and third time under J&K Governor N N Vohra tenure.

### Shillong Gets Selected As the 100th Smart City

Shillong, the capital city of Meghalaya has been selected as 100th Smart City, to receive funding under the Centre's flagship Smart Cities Mission, after evaluating the proposal submitted by it. Till now, 99 smart cities had been selected in four rounds of competition and with Shillong's selection, the list of 100 cities has been completed under the Smart Cities Mission.

### European Union Film Festival (EUFF) starts in New Delhi

European Union Film Festival (EUFF) 2018 is held in Siri Fort Auditorium, New Delhi. 24 latest European films from 23 European Union (EU) Member States have been selected for EUFF 2018.

### Niti Aayog's Composite Water Management Index

Minister for Water Resources Nitin Gadkari released Niti Aayog's composite water management index report in New Delhi. Gujarat topped the list while Jharkhand was adjudged as the worst performer. Gujarat is followed by Madhya Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka and Maharashtra.

### Maharashtra most vulnerable state

Maharashtra has been ranked the most vulnerable state in the draft National Disaster Risk Index, followed by West Bengal & Uttar Pradesh. States like Uttarakhand and Himachal Pradesh that are prone to natural calamities have been ranked relatively lower.

### Hyderabad ranks third in sound polluted cities list

The city of Hyderabad in Telangana has ranked third in The most sound polluted city list .It is also considered among the top 10 most air polluted metropolitan cities.

### Keshari Nath Tripathi to hold additional charge as Tripura Governor

President Ram Nath Kovind has given West Bengal Governor Keshari Nath Tripathi additional charge of Tripura Governor, during the absence of Tathagata Roy who is on leave.

### Agni 5 Missile test fired off Odisha coast

India successfully test fired its indigenously developed Agni- 5 missile. The missile was launched from Dr Abdul Kalam Island off the Odisha coast. This is the 6th test fire of the state-of-the-art Agni 5 missile.

### Andhra Pradesh gets separate state symbols post split

The state of Andhra Pradesh has notified its separate state symbols post-split and creation of Telangana in 2014. The announcement of the new symbols was made by the state department of environment, forest, science & technology.

## INTERNATIONAL

### Norway World's Best Country in Traffic Safety

According to a report from organization European Transport Safety Council (ETSC), Norway observes the lowest rate of traffic accidents in the world, leaving behind other European countries. Norway accounts for 20 deaths per one million inhabitants which is the lowest death rate in traffic since cars became common way of transportation in the post-war era.

### Pakistan placed on FATF's grey list

Pakistan has been placed on the Grey list of countries that financially aid terrorism, in Paris by the Financial Action Task Force (FATF). The placement on to grey list could hurt Pakistan's economy as well as its international standing.

### In a historic first, Saudi Arabia lifts ban on female drivers

In a first, women across Saudi Arabia were legally allowed to drive for the first time since 1957, thus, ending the world's last ban on female drivers which was seen as a symbol of women's repression in the deeply conservative Muslim kingdom.

### **UK Queen approves Brexit Bill**

Britain's Queen Elizabeth II granted royal assent to Prime Minister Theresa May's flagship Brexit legislation, that will formally end the country's European Union membership. The EU withdrawal bill repeals the 1972 European Communities Act through which the UK became a member of the bloc.

### **Tayyip Erdogan wins another term as Turkey President**

After 15 years in office, Turkey's President Recep Tayyip Erdogan is set to return to power once again for another 5 years following his outright election victory in the recently concluded polls. With 99 percent of votes counted, Mr Erdogan (64) won 53 percent votes and his closest rival Muharrem Ince won 31 percent.

### **Nepal out from ICAO's blacklist**

International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) has removed Nepal from its Significant Safety Concern (SSC) list. In 2013, the ICAO had enlisted Nepal in SSC category as Nepal's compliance to the ICAO's standard at that time stood only at 55 percent out of the standard 60 percent.

### **Wife of Israel PM charged with fraud over misuse of funds**

The wife of Israel's prime minister has been charged with fraud involving the alleged misuse of state funds. Sara Netanyahu has been indicted over claims she fraudulently ordered hundreds of meals to the prime minister's official residence in Jerusalem, spending more than \$100,000 (£76,000) of public money in the process.

### **World's 1st International centre for Humanitarian Forensics**

The world's first of its kind and state-of-the-art International Centre for 'Humanitarian Forensics' (ICHF) was launched at the Gujarat Forensic Sciences University in Gandhinagar, Gujarat.

### **Pradeep Parameswaran as new President of India & South Asia**

U.S. based ride hailing firm Uber has appointed Pradeep Parameswaran as new President of India and South Asia. This comes after Amit Jain was elevated to head the Asia Pacific region for Uber in May this year.

### **World's most Powerful Supercomputer unveiled**

US scientists have unveiled the world's most powerful and smart scientific supercomputer that can complete over 200,000 trillion calculations per second. The supercomputer will provide unprecedented computing power for research in energy, advanced materials and artificial intelligence.

**Ivan Duque to become Colombia's President**

Colombia has chosen Ivan Duque to be its next president after a long and divisive campaign that often centred on a controversial peace process with leftist rebels the Revolutionary Armed Forces of Colombia (FARC).

**Former World bank economist Omar Al-Razzaz sworn in as Jordan PM**

Former World Bank Economist Omar al-Razzaz was sworn in as Jordan's Prime Minister after King Abdullah issued a decree approving the new government. Omar succeeded Hani al-Mulki who resigned following mass protests over price hikes and other government economic policies.

**Rizvi sworn in as caretaker Pak Punjab CM**

Professor Hasan Askari Rizvi took charge as the caretaker chief minister of Pakistan's Punjab Province. Hasan Askari Rizvi was administered oath of office and secrecy at the Governor's House in Lahore.

**Jordan king appoints Omar Razzaz as new Prime Minister**

Jordan's King Abdullah II appointed a new prime minister in hopes of quelling the largest anti-government protests in recent years. Cabinet member Omar Razzaz, a Harvard-educated former senior World Bank official, replaced Hani Mulki.

**Rajoy forced out as Spain's Prime Minister**

Spanish Prime Minister Mariano Rajoy was toppled by a corruption scandal, becoming the first leader in Spain's modern democracy to lose a vote of no confidence in Parliament.

**Microsoft is now third most Valuable Firm globally**

Microsoft has surpassed Alphabet, the parent company of Google, in the market capitalisation for the first time in three years, becoming the third most valuable firm after Apple and Amazon globally. Microsoft had a market cap of \$753 billion at the close of trading, almost \$14 billion ahead of Alphabet.

**Pedro Sanchez replaces Mariano Rajoy as Spain's new prime minister**

Pedro Sanchez took over as Spain's Prime Minister after outgoing leader Mariano Rajoy lost a parliamentary confidence vote triggered by a long-running corruption trial involving members of his centre-right party.

**Abdel Fattah Al-Sisi sworn in as Egyptian President**

In Egypt, President Abdel Fattah al-Sisi was sworn in for a second four-year term in office as the country faces major economic and security challenges. Sisi won 97% of valid votes in the March presidential election.

### **Giuseppe Conte Sworn in as Italy PM**

Giuseppe Conte was sworn in as prime minister of Italy's new populist government. Conte, an academic and political novice, will head a government of ministers from the anti-establishment Five Star Movement (M5S) and the far-right League Party.

### **Paraguay gets Its 1st Woman Interim President**

Paraguay gets first interim woman President Alicia Pucheta for the first time in its history after outgoing leader Horacio Cartes stepped down ahead of schedule. Vice President Alicia Pucheta will complete Carter's mandate after he resigned to become a senator.

## **INDIA & WORLD**

### **India Ranked 4th for Web Attacks Globally: Report**

According to a report titled "Summer 2018 State of the Internet/ Security: Web Attack report" compiled by Cloud delivery network provider Akamai Technologies, India is ranked fourth in the list of top 10 target countries for Web Application Attacks.

### **Mumbai costlier than Washington and Melbourne**

According to a Mercer survey, Mumbai is the most expensive city in India to live in for expatriates as compared to Washington and Melbourne. Hong Kong is ranked as the world's costliest city to live in for expatriates, followed by Tokyo, Zurich, Singapore, and Seoul. Bengaluru, which has a high population of expatriates is getting more reasonable on cost of living.

### **India most dangerous country for women**

India is the world's most dangerous country for women due to the high risk of sexual violence and being forced into slave labour. War-torn Afghanistan and Syria ranked second and third in the Thomson Reuters Foundation survey of about 550 experts on women's issues.

### **US surpasses India as top greenfield FDI investment destination globally: FDI Report 2018**

According to the FDI Report 2018 compiled by FDI Intelligence, a division of The Financial Times Ltd., US has surpassed India as the top destination to attract Greenfield FDI investment.

**India among over 90 nations without paid paternity leave: UNICEF**  
According to the new analysis by UNICEF, India is among almost 90 countries in the world

without national policies in place that ensure new fathers get adequate paid time off with their newborn babies.

### **India ranks 177 in Environmental Performance Index 2018**

India has been ranked at 177 out of 180 countries in the 2018 Environmental Performance Index (EPI). India has become the fourth worst country in the world with an air quality score of 5.75 out of 100. India was placed at 141 out of 180 in 2016. The top five countries in terms of green rankings are Switzerland, France, Denmark, Malta and Sweden.

### **India to host first BIMSTEC Military Exercise**

India will host the first military exercise of the BIMSTEC (Bay of Bengal Initiative for Multi-Sectoral Technical and Economic Cooperation) group focussing on counter-terrorism in September.

### **India-Nepal Joint Ex SURYA KIRAN-XIII Culminates**

The 14-day long joint military training exercise SURYA KIRAN-XIII between India & Nepal culminated at Pithoragarh. The training culminated with a 72-hour outdoor exercise in which troops of both contingents carried out a Cordon and Search Operation in a mock counter-insurgency village.

### **India is the second highest sender of Foreign Students in US**

With 1,86,000 Indian students currently studying in the United States, India is the second highest sender of foreign students to the US, next only to China. US consul general in Kolkata, Craig Hall, stated that the United States is the top destination for foreign students worldwide and the number of Indian students in the US has more than doubled in the last 10 years.

### **India ranks 137th on Global Peace Index 2018**

According to a report by an Australian think tank, India has moved up four places to the 137th rank among 163 countries on the 2018 Global Peace Index. Iceland remains the most peaceful country in the world, a position it has held since 2008. New Zealand, Austria, Portugal and Denmark also sit in the top five most peaceful rankings.

### **India to import first Russian LNG Cargo**

India will receive the first-ever cargo of liquefied natural gas (LNG) from Russia as New Delhi diversifies import basket to meet its vast energy needs. State-owned gas utility GAIL India Ltd will bring the shipload of LNG from Gazprom, a Russian supplier, at Petronet LNG Ltd import terminal in Dahej, Gujarat

### **3rd meeting of India-UK home affairs dialogue held in New Delhi**

The Third Home Affairs' Dialogue between India and U.K. was held in New Delhi. The Government of India Delegation was led by Mr Rajiv Gauba, Union Home Secretary and the Delegation from Home Office of the U.K. was led by its Second Permanent Secretary, Ms. Patsy Wilkinson.

### **India improves its childhood index global ranking**

India has been placed at 113th position in the list of 175 countries in "End of Childhood Index 2018" indexed by global child rights group, Save the Children.

### **US Pacific Command renamed as US Indo-Pacific Command**

The United States has renamed its oldest and largest military command – the Pacific Command – to Indo-Pacific Command, in a largely symbolic move to signal India's importance to the US military.

## **CONFERENCES**

### **Monsoon Session of Parliament**

The Monsoon Session of Parliament will be held from July. It will span over 24 days & will have 18 sittings. It was formally announced by Cabinet Committee of Parliamentary Affairs (CCPA) chaired by Home Minister Rajnath Singh. The CCPA recommendation now sets in summoning motion process of President Ram Nath Kovind for formally convening the session.

### **15th India-Australia joint ministerial commission**

The 15th India-Australia Joint Ministerial Commission (JMC) was held in Canberra, Australia. The meeting was jointly chaired by Minister of Commerce & Industry and Civil Aviation, Suresh Prabhu and Australian Minister for Trade, Tourism and Investment Steven Ciobo.

### **3rd annual meeting of AIIB**

The 3rd annual meeting of the Beijing based Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) began in Mumbai. This first time India is hosting the event. The meeting with the theme 'Mobilizing Finance for Infrastructure' was inaugurated by PM Modi.

### **19th all India Conference of Directors**

Union Minister of State for Home Affairs, Shri Hansraj Gangaram Ahir will inaugurate the 19th all India Conference of Directors of Finger Prints Bureaux in Hyderabad. During the two-day conference, participants will deliberate on latest Automatic Fingerprint Identification Systems (AFIS).

### **India-Greece business forum meeting**

On the occasion of the official visit of the President of the Republic of India to Athens, a Business Forum the ‘Greece-India Business Forum’ was organized in Athens.

### 7th OPEC International seminar

The Organization of the Petroleum Exporting Countries (OPEC) will host the 7th OPEC International Seminar at the Imperial Hofburg Palace in Vienna, Austria. The theme of the Seminar is ‘Petroleum – cooperation for a sustainable future’.

### Nadal won 11th French Open title

Rafael Nadal claimed an 11th French Open title in Men's singles final in Paris after defeating Austrian Dominic Thiem in straight sets 6-4 6-3 6-2. The 32-year-old world number one now has 17 Grand Slam titles, just three behind great rival Roger Federer.

The 2018 Asian Junior Athletics Championships was the 18th edition of the International athletics competition for Asian under-20 athletes.

#### SBI MD Sriram Resigns

SBI managing director B Sriram has resigned from the country's largest lender after his appointment as chief executive of IDBI Bank. The development assumes significance amid reports that insurance behemoth LIC is mulling acquiring a majority stake in the debt-ridden state-owned bank.

#### Pakistan's National Security advisor Nasser Khan Janjua resigns

Pakistan's National Security Advisor Nasser Khan Janjua resigned from his post. Succeeding Sartaj Aziz, Janjua took over as Pakistan's NSA in October 2015, he served as the NSA since then.

#### Justice Chelameswar retires from SC

Jasti Chelameswar has retired as Supreme Court judge on June 2018. Justice Chelameswar, who had held presser along with three other Supreme Court judges to highlight discrimination in allocation of cases to benches, said that the credibility of the highest judiciary in danger.

#### Sanjay Kumar quits Indigo

IndiGo's Chief Commercial Officer Sanjay Kumar resigns from the office. S. Kumar has been associated with the organisation from past 12 years. William Boulter, the current Chief Strategy Officer, would be taking over from him.

#### Supreme court judge Jasti Chelameswar resigns

Supreme court judge Jasti Chelameswar will resign after a nearly 07 year tenure in the apex court. Justice Jasti Chelameswar is one of three judges, who has opposed Chief Justice of India (CJI) Deepak Misra's selective allocation of cases.

#### Intel CEO Brian Krzanich Resigns

Intel Corp. removed Brian Krzanich as chief executive officer after the chipmaker learned he had a "past consensual relationship" with an employee, a violation of the company's policies. Chief Financial Officer Robert Swan was named interim chief executive officer, effective immediately.

**CEA Arvind Subramanian resigned**

The Chief Economic Advisor (CEA) of India, Arvind Subramanian had resigned from the post and will return to the US because of “pressing family commitments”. The announcement was made by Mr Arun Jaitley.

**Mehbooba Mufti resigns as J&K CM**

Jammu & Kashmir's Chief Minister Mehbooba Mufti submitted her resignation to the Governor after BJP announced to pull out of an alliance with Peoples Democratic Party (PDP). The reason for the pullout was failure to control the situation in the state and meet its promises.

**Former AirAsia India CEO Mittu Chandilya resigns from Adani Group**

Former AirAsia India CEO Mittu Chandilya announced his resignation from Adani Group. Mittu's resignation has come at a time, when the Central Bureau of Investigation has registered a case against the airline for allegedly hiring lobbyist to change the 5/20 foreign flying norms.

**World's most experienced Spacewoman Peggy Whitson retires**

NASA's record-breaking astronaut, Peggy Whitson, retired after a 22-year-long career. Whitson, who joined NASA as a researcher in 1986, has spent more time off Earth than any other American, totalling 665 days over three International Space Station missions.

**Georgia's prime minister Giorgi Kvirikashvili resigns**

Prime Minister of Georgia Giorgi Kvirikashvili has announced his resignation. He resigned due to a disagreement with Bidzina Ivanishvili, the leader of the ruling party and growing popular unrest and discontent over his government's handling of the economy.

**Cricket coach Hesson quits**

New Zealand cricket coach Mr. Mike Hesson resigned from his post. He has been the coach for the national team of New Zealand for 6 years.

**Cricket Australia CEO Sutherland announces resignation**

Cricket Australia Chief Executive Officer James Sutherland informed the Chairman & board of Cricket Australia his intention to resign from his current position. ### **India is the largest borrower from AIIB**

With the total project portfolios of US\$4.4 Billion, India has been the largest borrower of Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) lending since the time the Bank started its operations. Unlike most other multilateral development banks set up by advanced economies, AIIB is the first major multilateral development bank where principal contributors are the borrowing members themselves.

The move will help attract more overseas flows and thereby help arrest the recent fall in the rupee on one hand and also lift the recent fall in demand for corporate bonds.

### **Mobile Banking rank by SBI’s annual report**

At 17.2%, Axis Bank commands the largest value share of mobile banking transactions but it’s Paytm that tops volumes with 22%. However, Paytm’s value share is a meagre 0.25%, according to State Bank of India’s (SBI) annual report for 2017-18 which has put out RBI’s data for January 2018.

### **RBI to raise \$30-35 bn via NRI bonds**

On the backdrop of rising oil prices and shortfall in FPI inflows to the country the RBI is expected to raise \$30-35 billion via NRI bonds to raise the rupee . FPI has been slowed down amidst political volatility and with listing of Chinese firms in global benchmark indices.

### **RBI Hikes Repo Rate By 25 Basis Points To 6.25%**

In its second bi-monthly monetary policy review, the six member Monetary Policy Committee headed by RBI Governor Urjit Patel unanimously hiked the policy repo rate by 25 basis points to 6.25 percent to curb inflationary pressure from rising crude prices.

**SBI, PNB, ICICI Banks rises lending rates**

India's major banks SBI, PNB and ICICI Bank raised the lending rate making the loans costlier. SBI has increased the lending rate by 10 basis points across all tenors up to three years. The state-owned Punjab National (PNB), the country's second largest lender, raised the MCLR for three-year and five-year tenors to 8.55% and 8.7%, respectively. Country's second largest private bank ICICI Bank too said it has raised five-year tenor MCLR by 10 bps to 8.70%. It has also raised the MCLR by 10 bps in loans with tenor of one year and three years.
