<b>Canada</b>	Federation with a strong Centre Vesting of residuary powers in the Centre Appointment of state governors by the Centre Advisory jurisdiction of the Supreme Court
<b>Ireland</b>	Directive Principles of State Policy Nomination of members to Rajya Sabha Method of election of the president
<b>Japan</b>	Procedure Established by law
<b>Soviet Union (USSR)</b>	Fundamental duties Ideals of justice (social, economic and political) in the Preamble
