Other Members of UPSC	No Minimum age limit	65	6 years or up to age of 65 years which is earlier
President of India	35	No such Maximum age limit	5 years
Rajya Sabha Member	30	No Maximum age limit	6 years
Vice President	35	No such Maximum age limit	6 years
