- Air-conditioned, Three-tier coaches, and a Sleeper class introduced in 1993

- India's First Train ran between - Red Hills to Chintadripet bridge (Madras)
- India's first compressed natural gas (CNG)-powered train Inaugurated on 13th January 2015 (Rewari – Rohtak)
- India's first Metro Train ran from Esplanade to Bhowanipur (now the Netaji Bhawan station) in Calcutta
- India's first tramway (horse-drawn) opened in Calcutta on 24 February 1873
- First Railway to introduce electric lighting as standard fixtures at Jodhpur Railway (1902)
- India's longest Pir Panjal Railway Tunnel is located between Quazigund and Banihal
- India's Oldest Working Locomotive that is still in use Fairy Queen
- Most visited railway museum in India National Rail Museum at New Delhi

- Indian Railway Institute of Mechanical and Electrical Engineering (IRIMEE) located Jamalpur, Bihar
- Indian Railway Track Gauge are 1,676 mm; 1,000 mm; 762 mm; 610 mm
